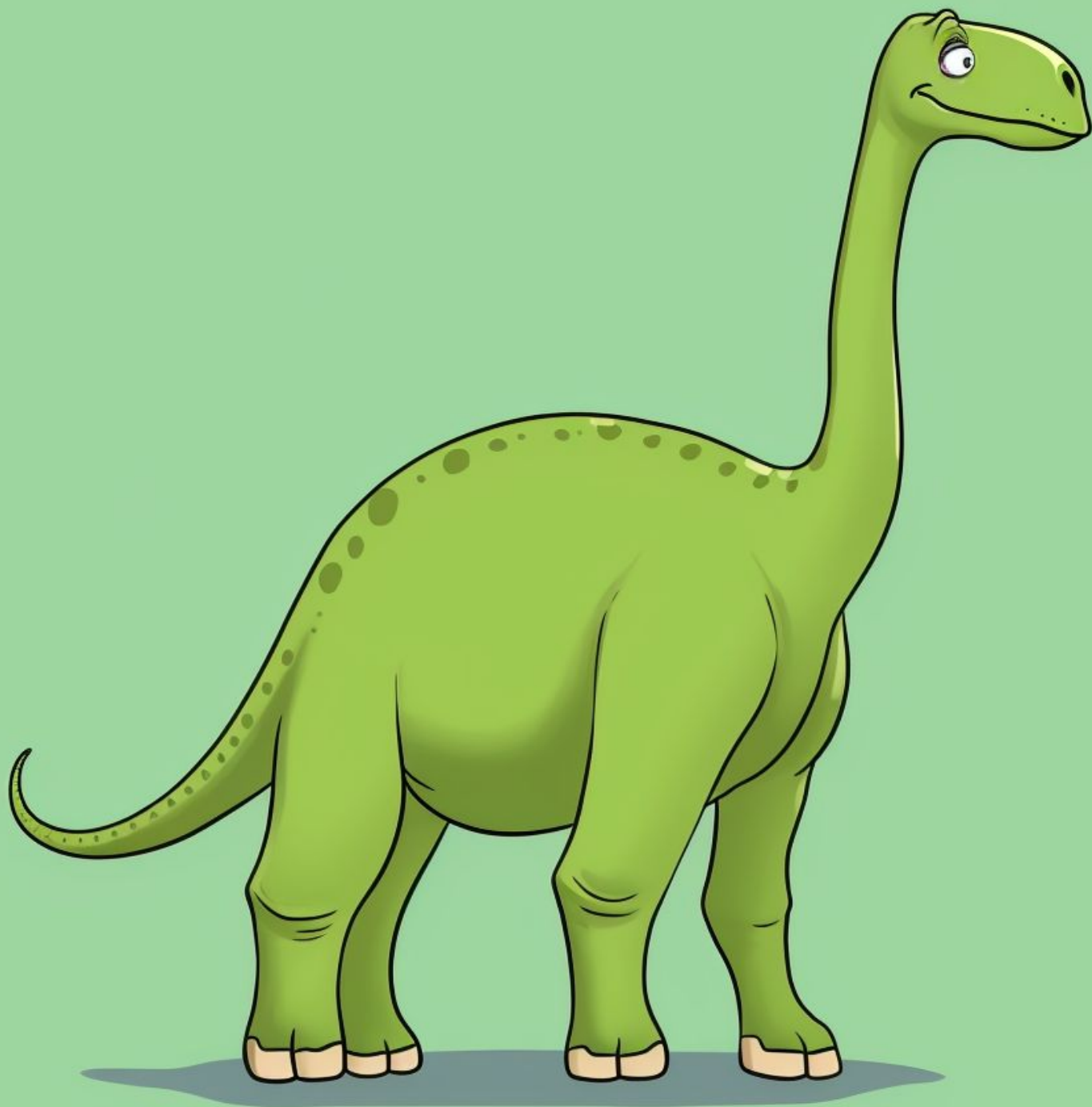

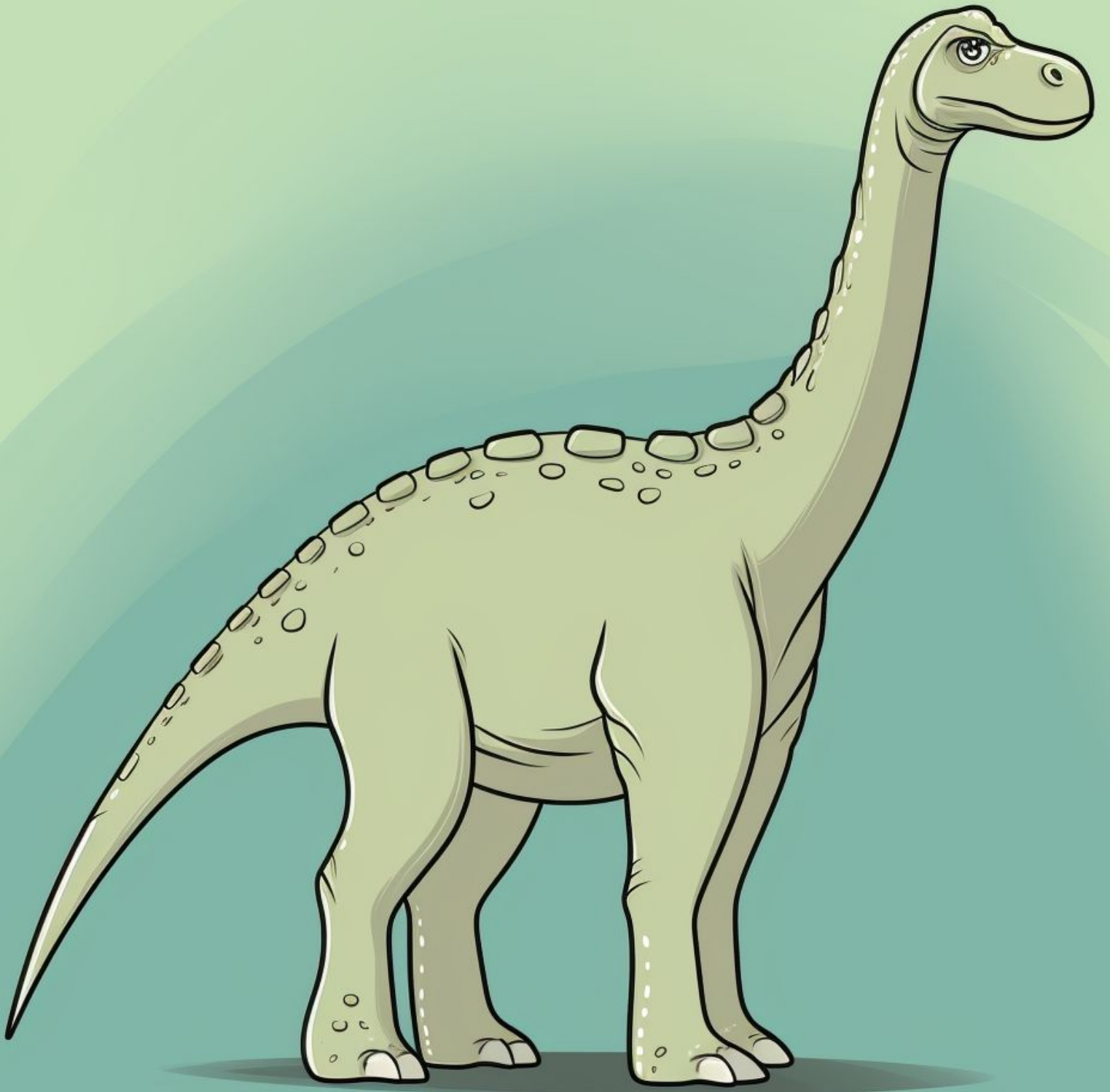


Aa

Brachiosaurus was a giant dinosaur that had a long neck and liked to eat leaves from tall trees.

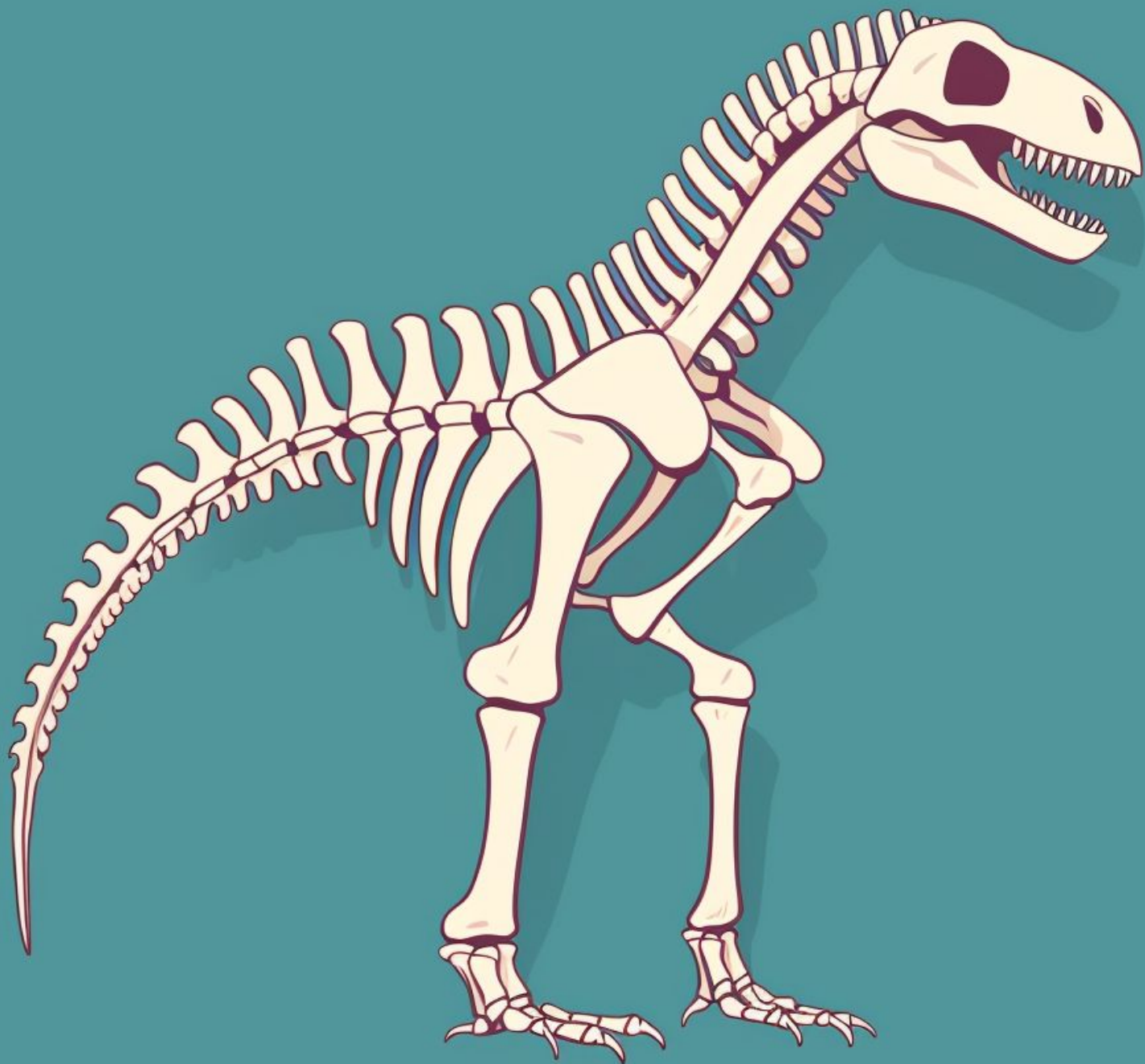


Cc

Extinct means that dinosaurs aren't around anymore, but we can still learn about them from their fossils.



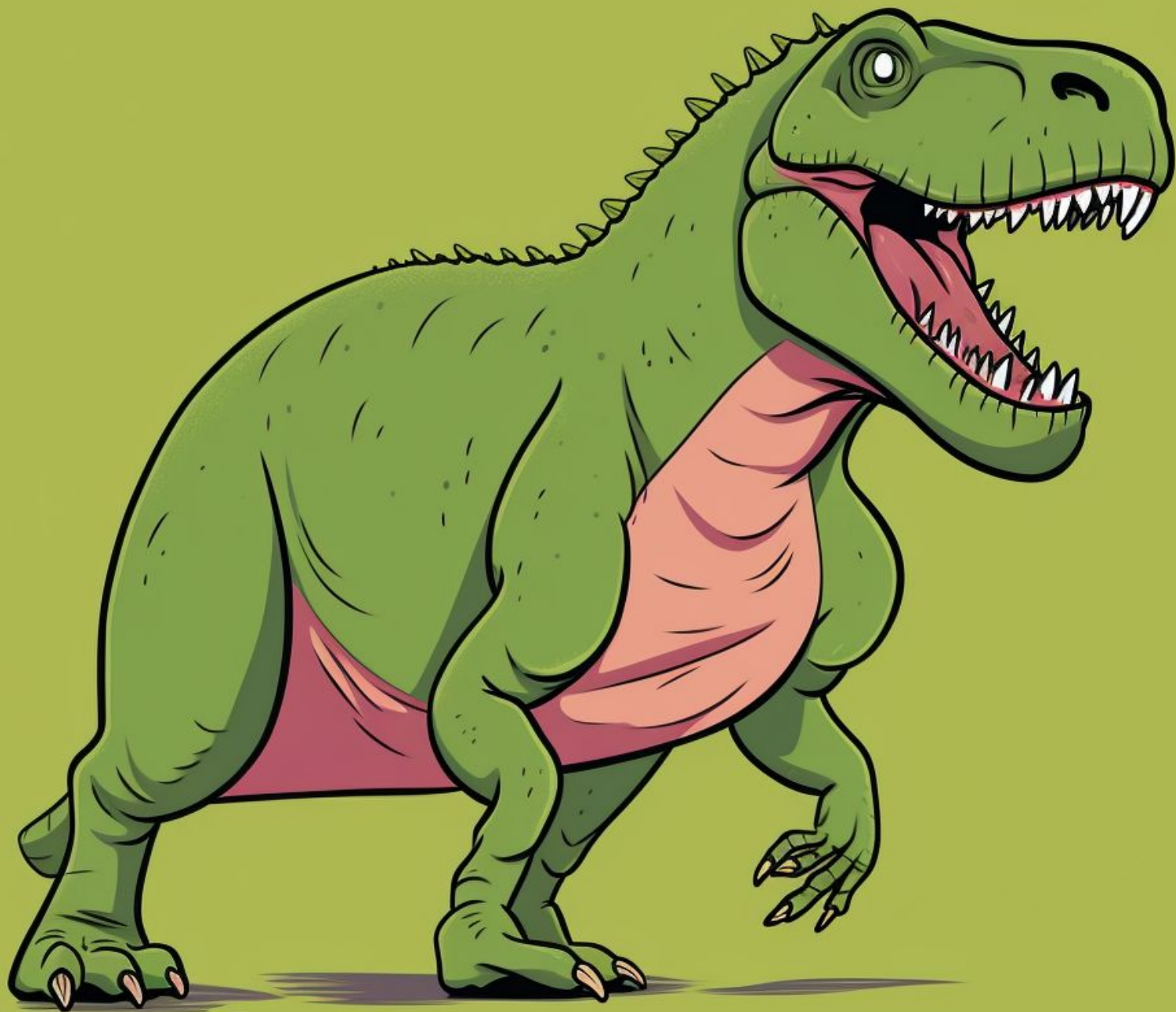


Ff

The Jurassic Period was a long time ago when many dinosaurs lived, and it was like a giant dinosaur party!



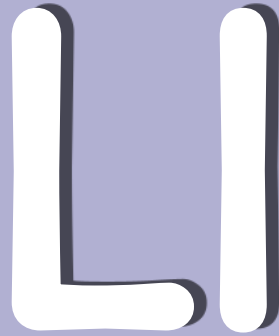
# Kk

T-Rex, short for Tyrannosaurus rex, was a huge, fierce meat-eating dinosaur with tiny arms and big teeth.

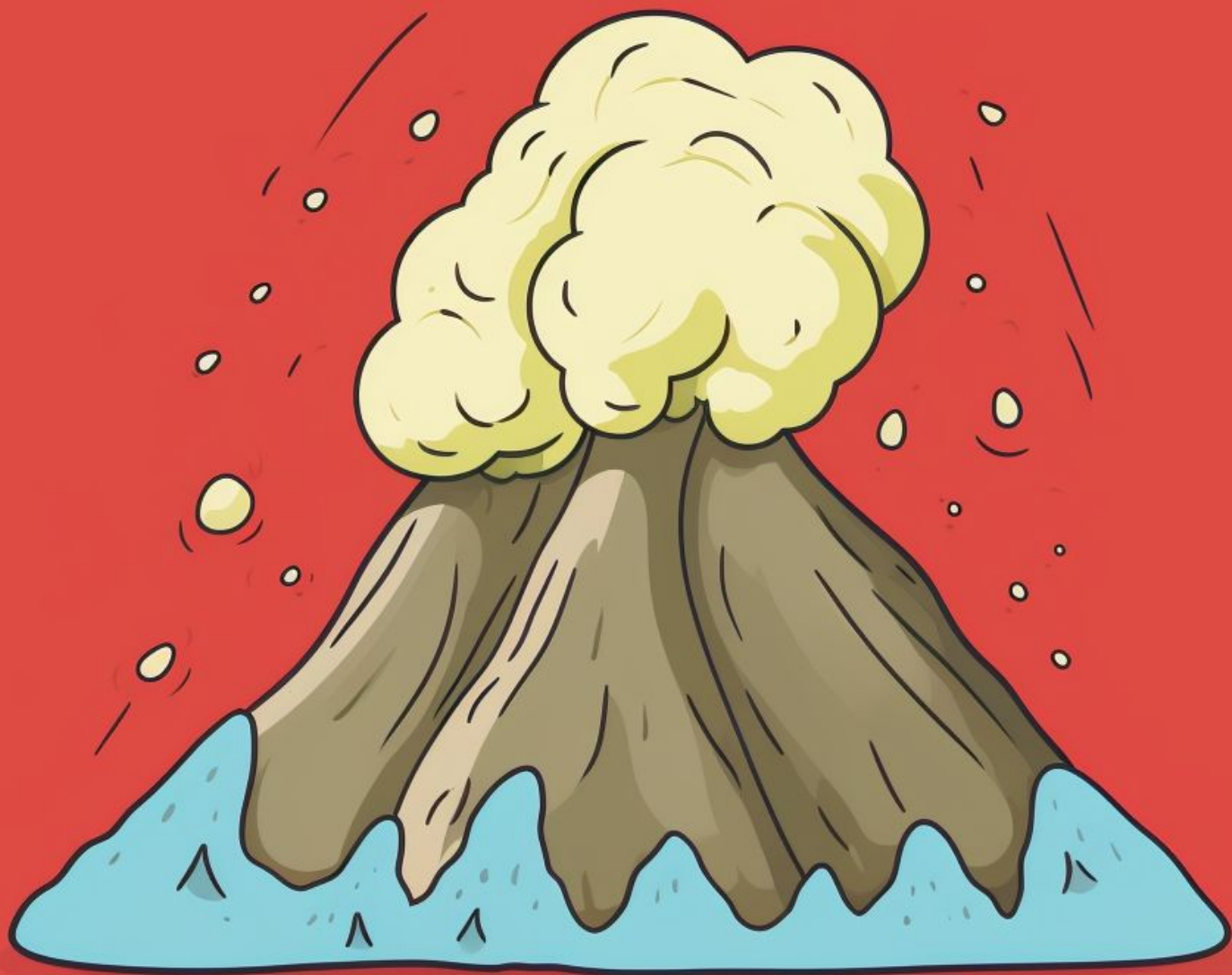


Uu

Utahraptor was a fast-running dinosaur that liked to hunt in packs with its raptor friends.



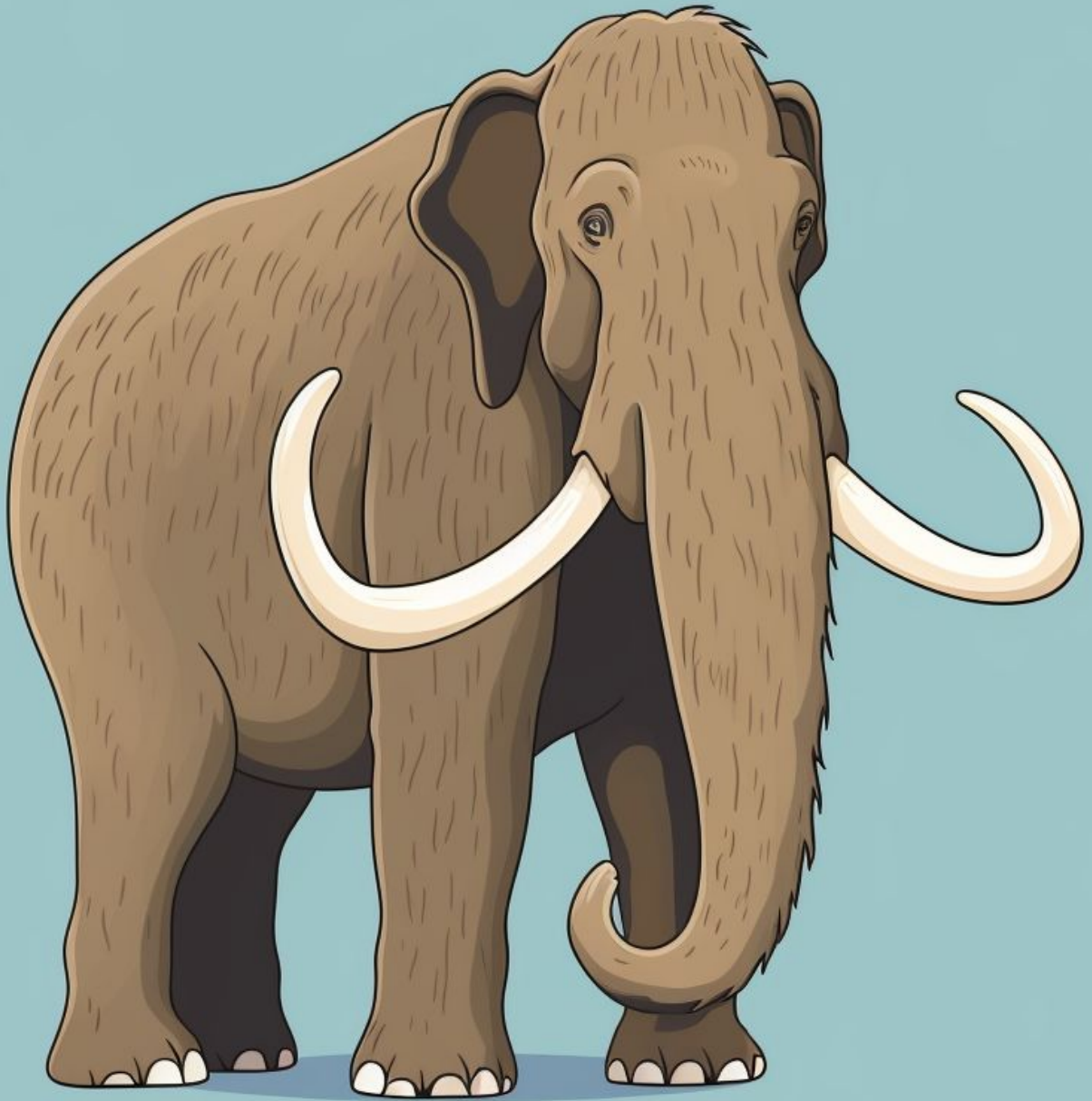


Vv

Some scientists think that volcanoes might have caused the end of the dinosaurs by making the Earth really hot.

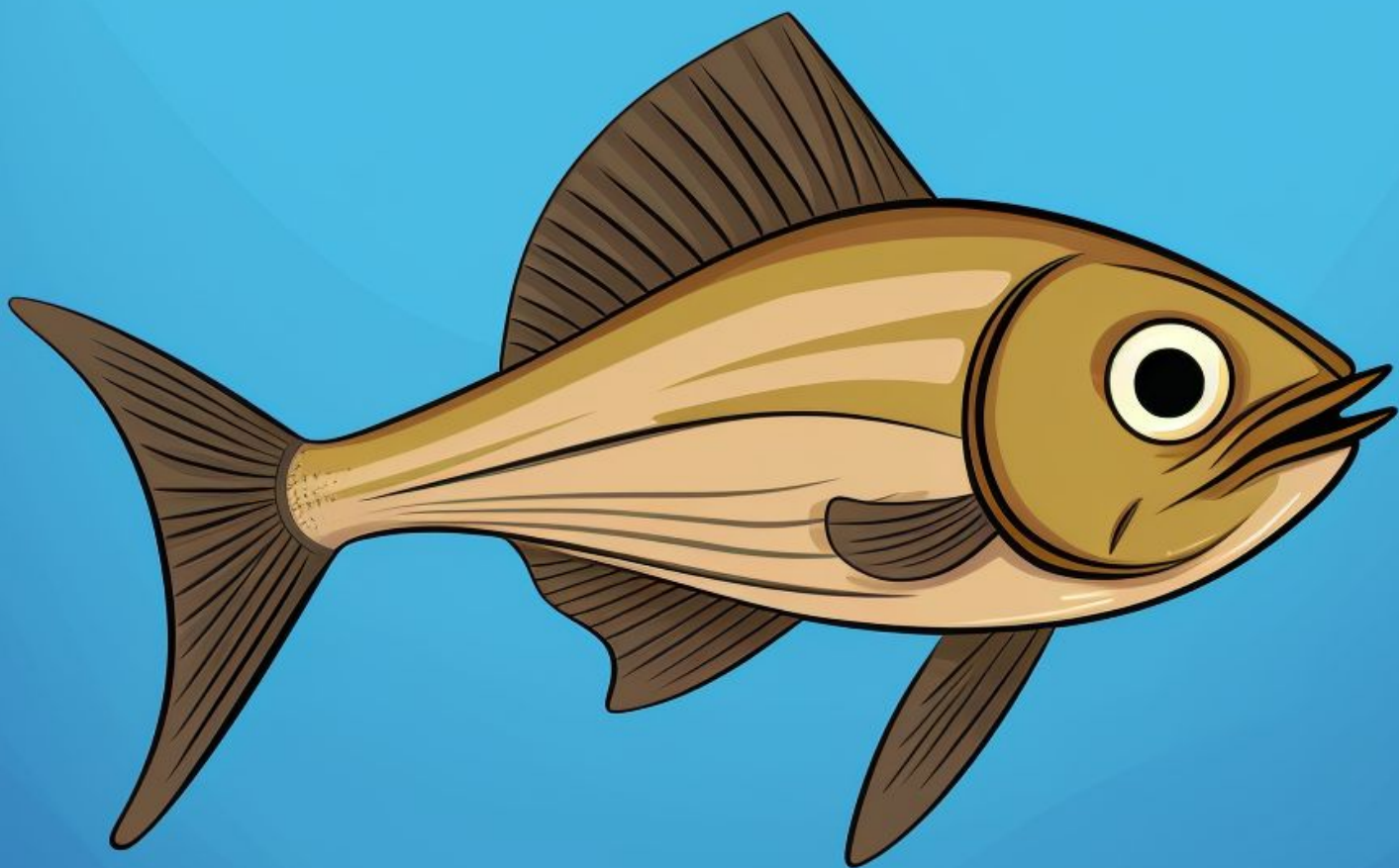


Ww
