A condo is like a mix between an apartment and a house, and you own it, but you also share some spaces with neighbors.

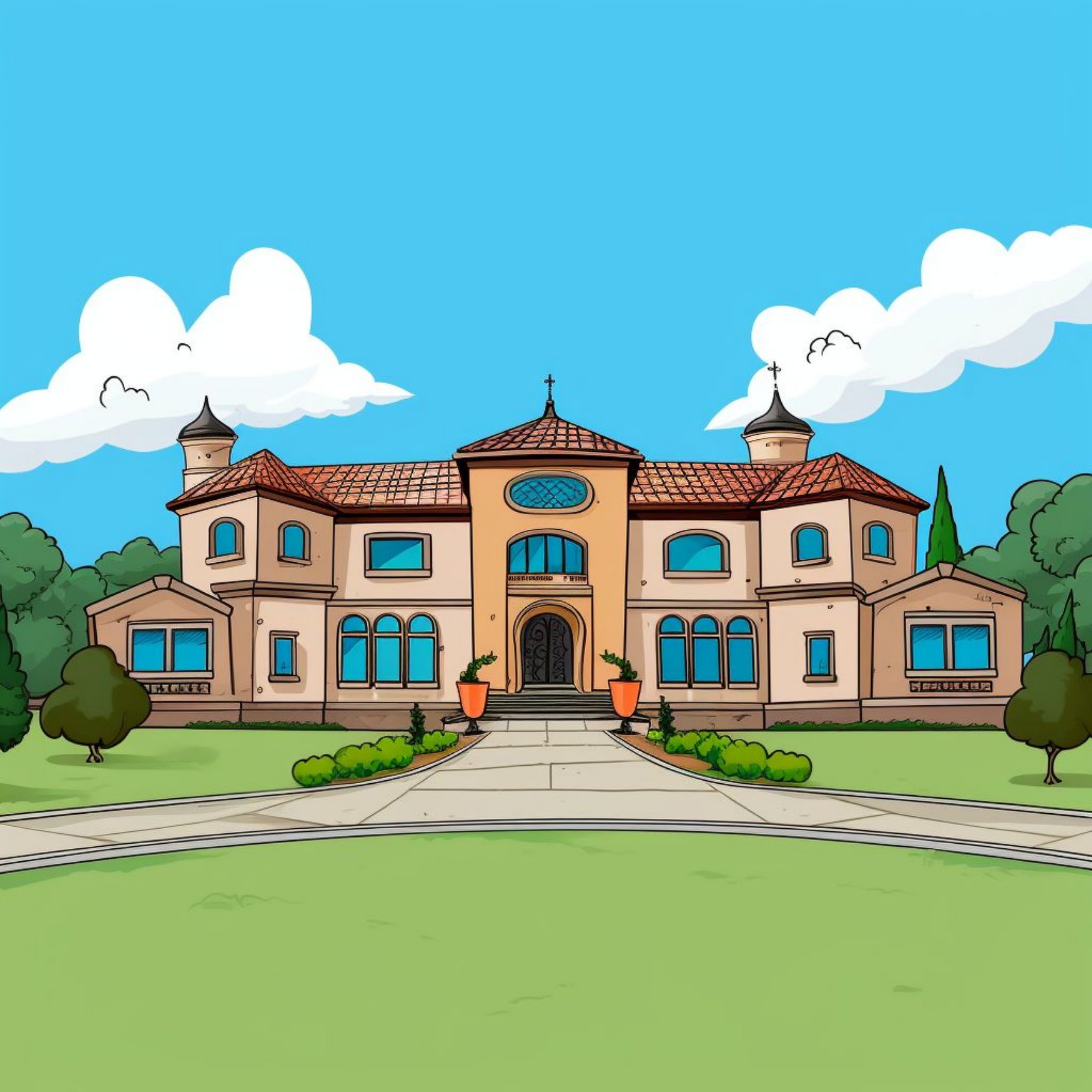


Dd

A duplex is like a house that's divided into two separate homes, one on top of the other.

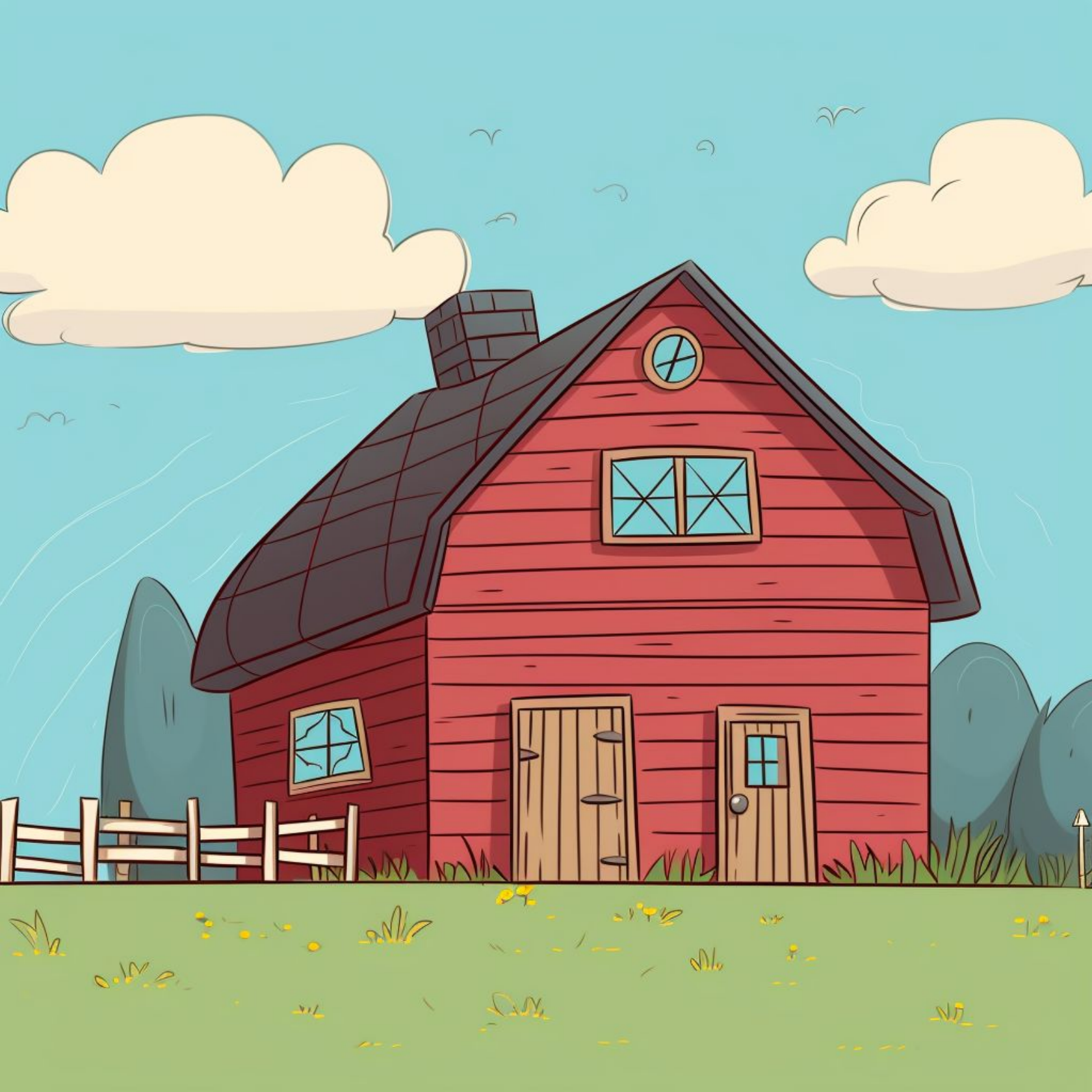


Ee

A high-rise is like a super tall building with lots of floors, and it's often found in busy cities.

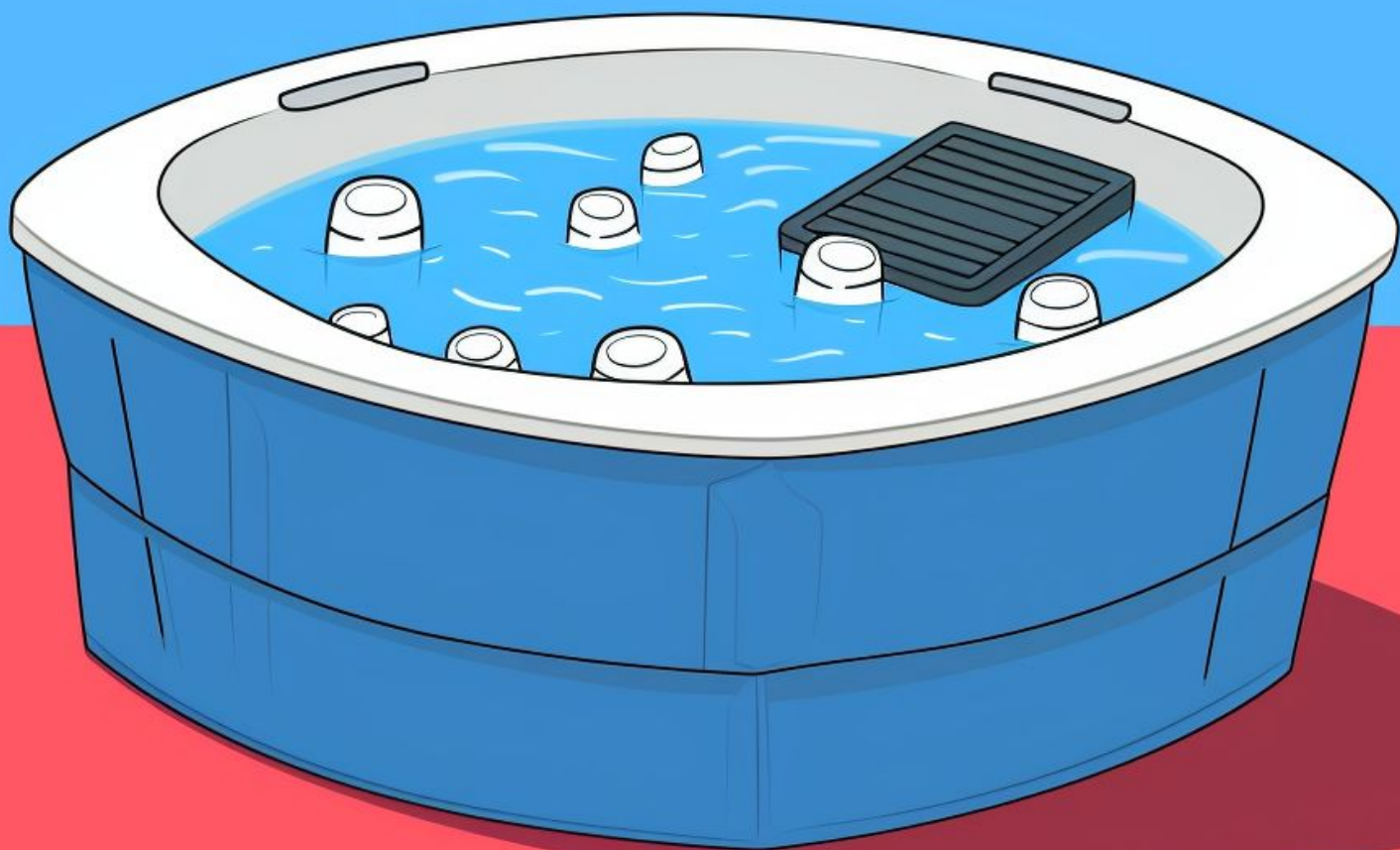


Ii

A kitchen is like the heart of the house, where you cook yummy meals and bake delicious treats.

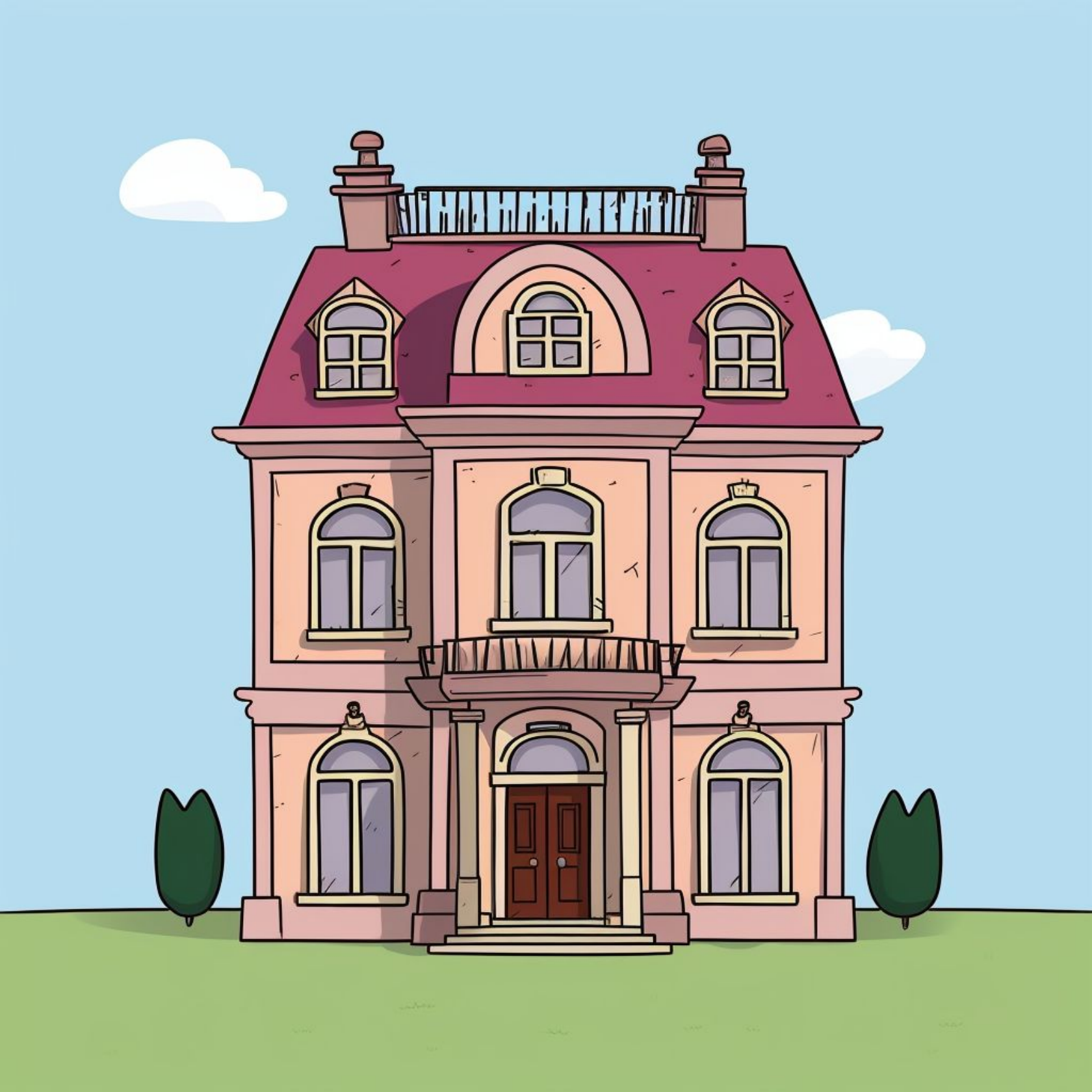

A suburb is like a quieter area just outside a big city, with houses, parks, and schools.

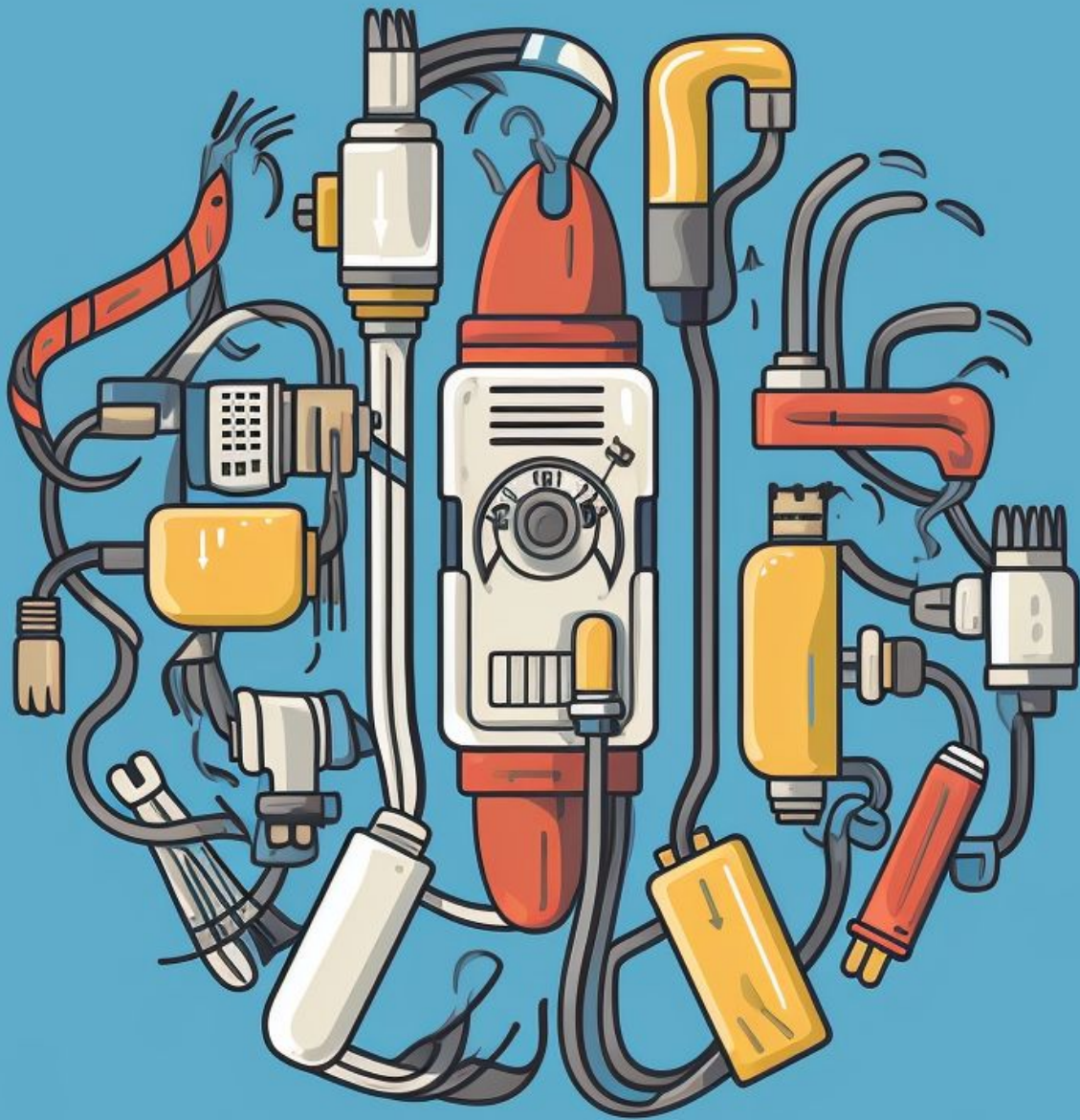


Tt

A yard is like the outdoor space around your house, where you can play, have picnics, or plant flowers.

Zero Down Payment

This means you don't have to pay any money upfront when buying a house, but it's not very common!
