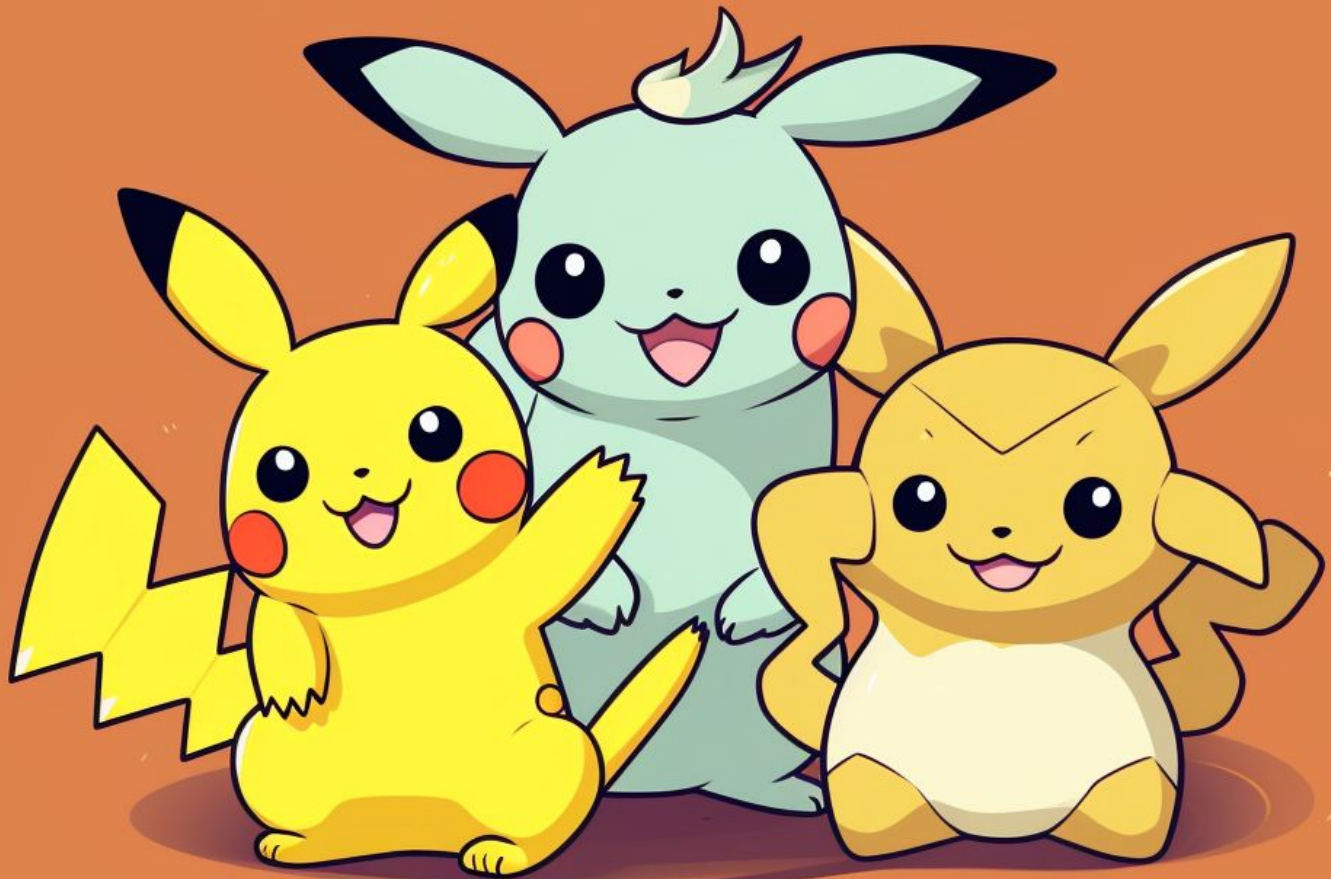

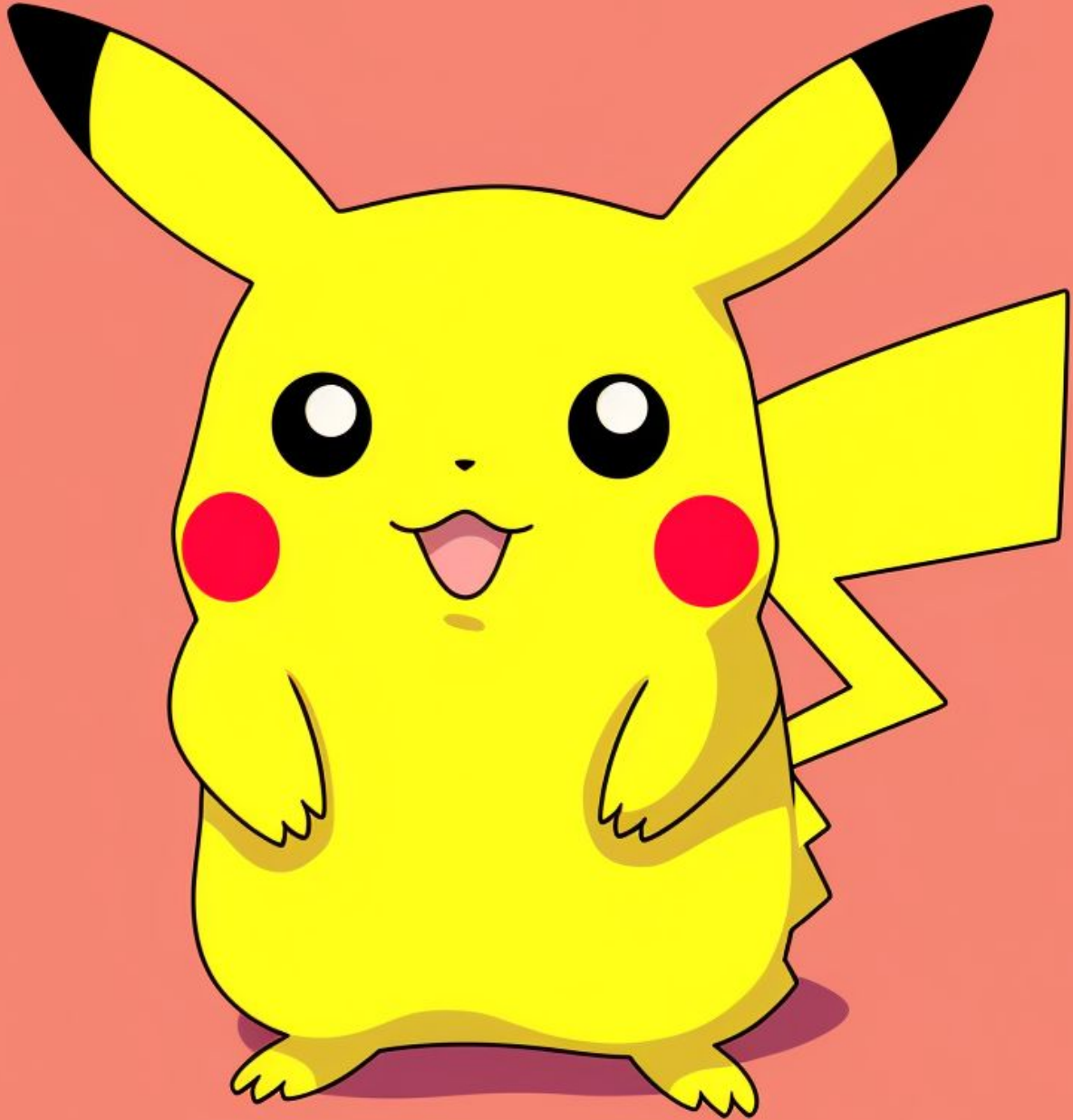

put others to sleep with its song.

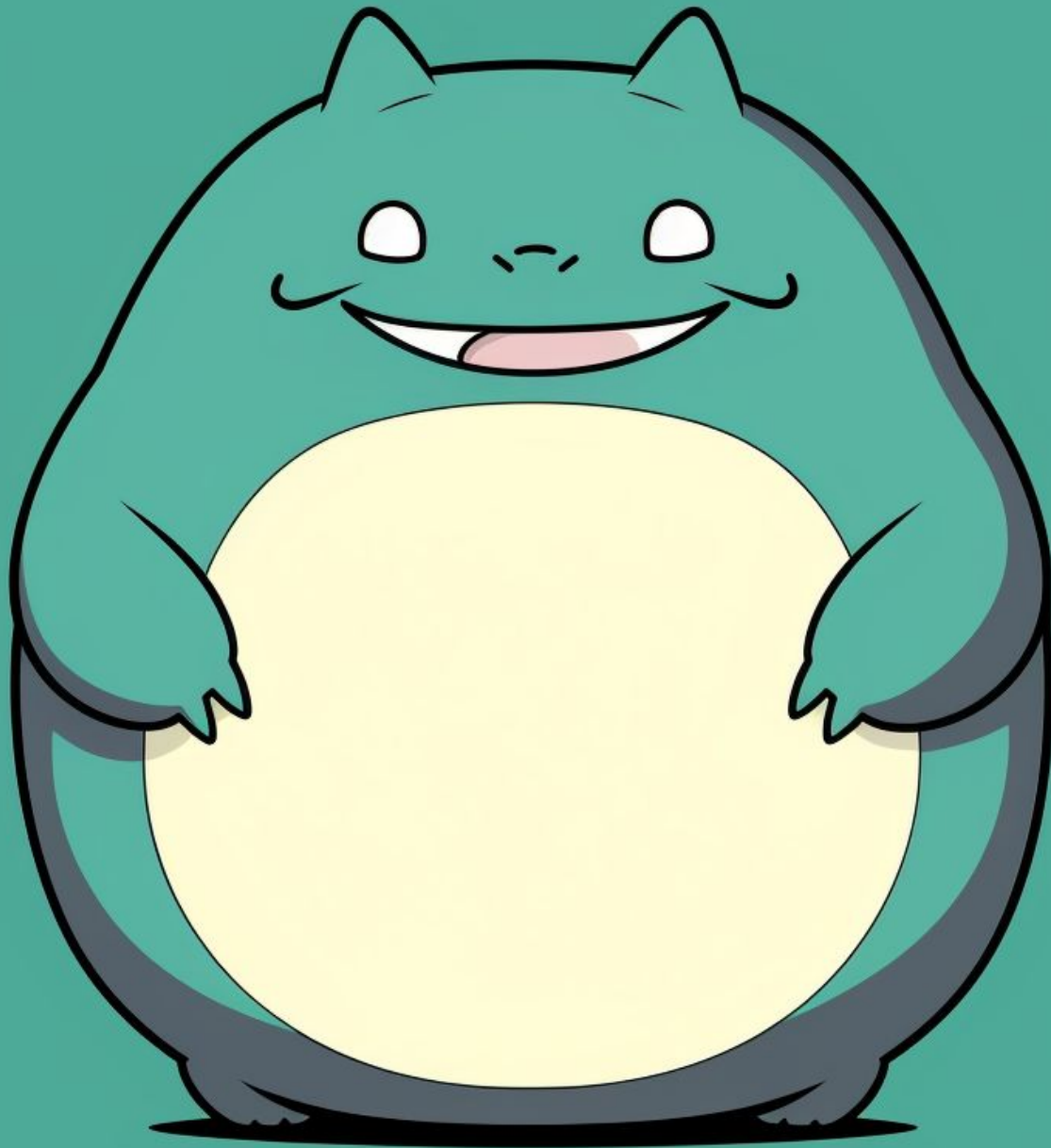


Gg

Jynx is a graceful and psychic ice-type Pokémon with long hair.

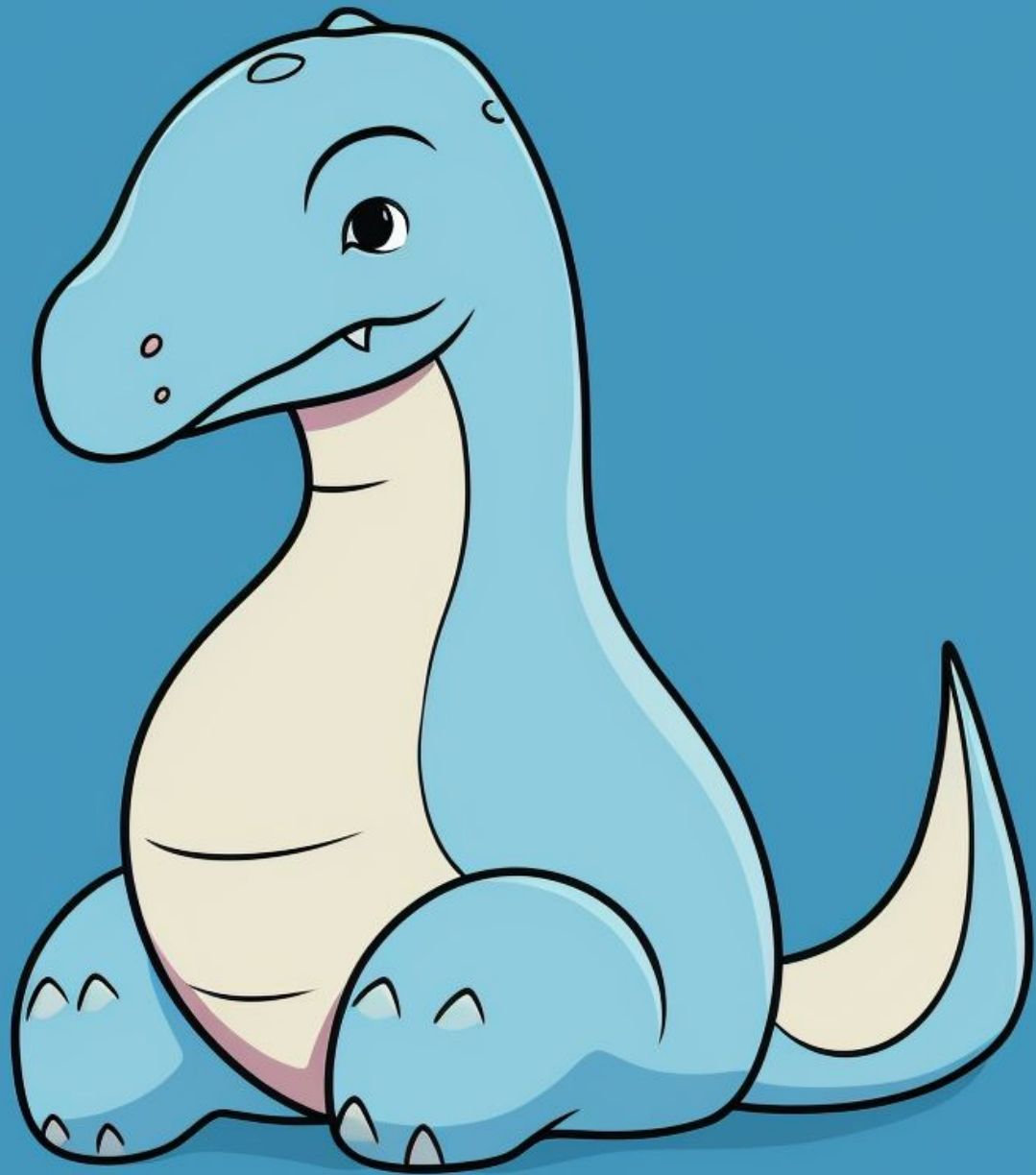


Kk

resembles a snake.

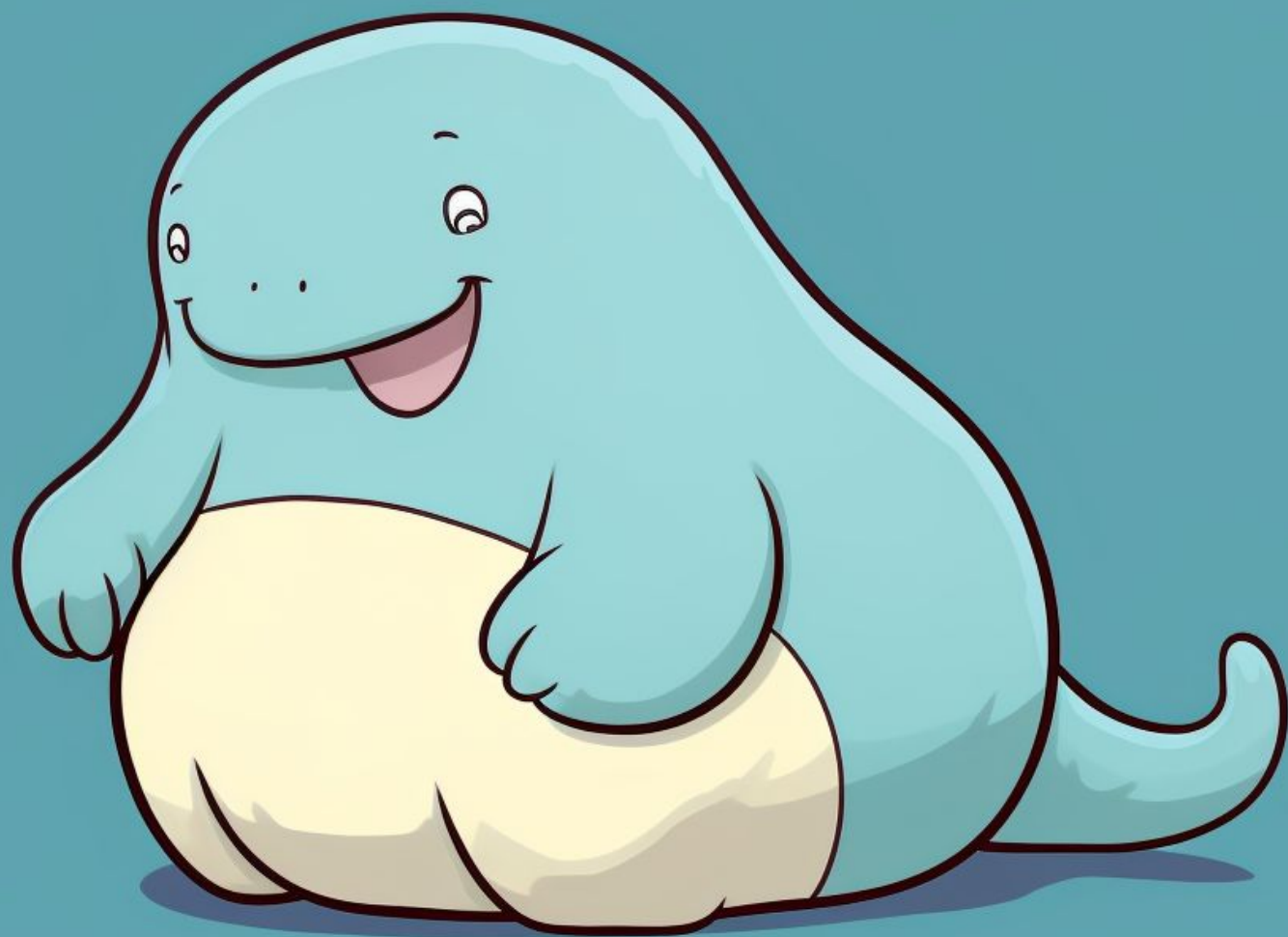


Pp

Umbreon is a dark-type Eevee evolution known for its mysterious appearance.

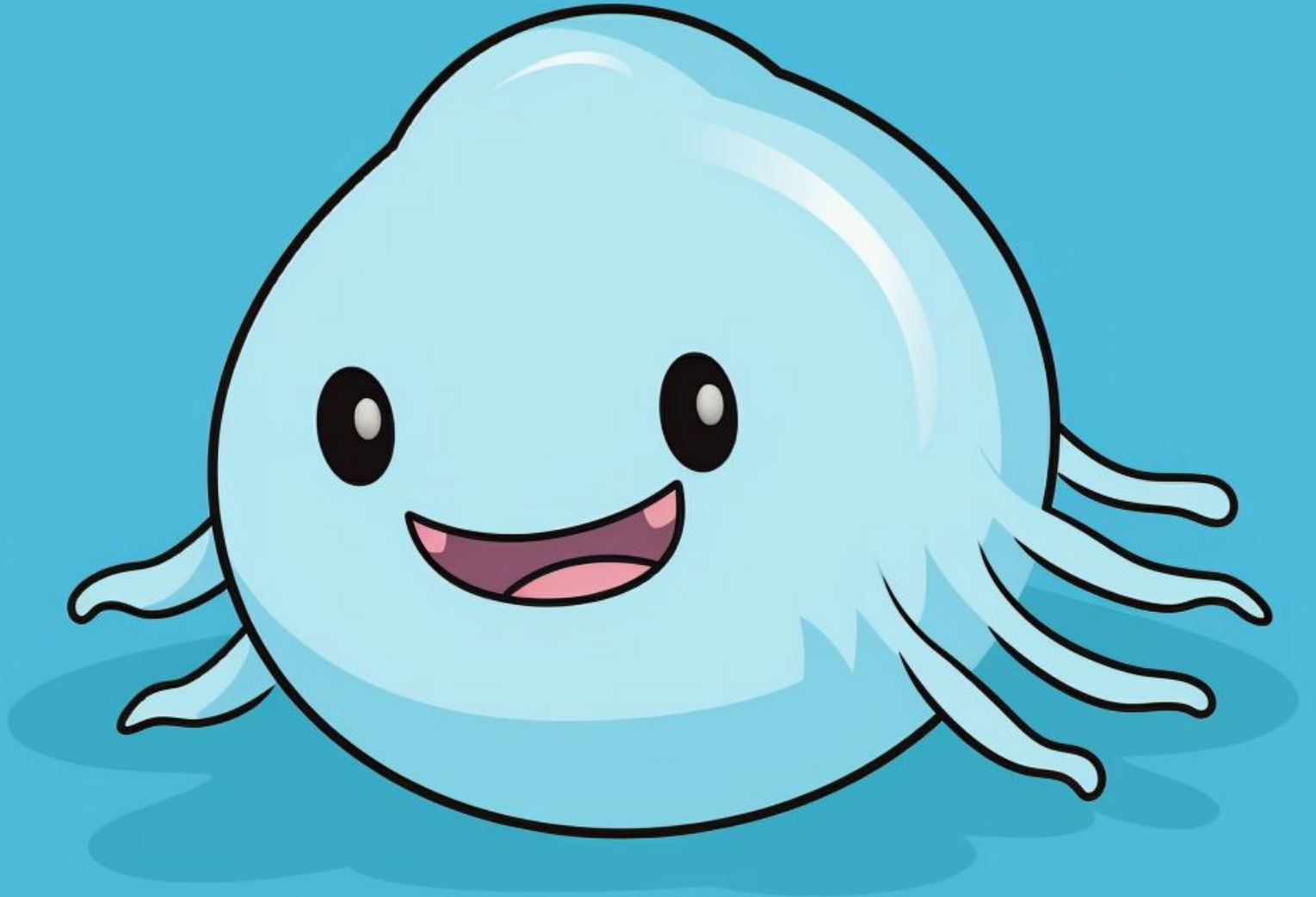


Vv

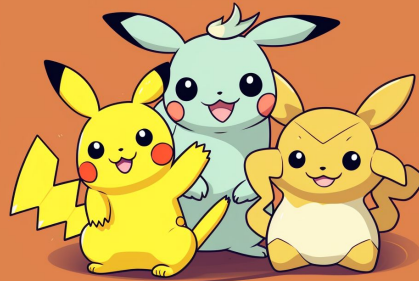
