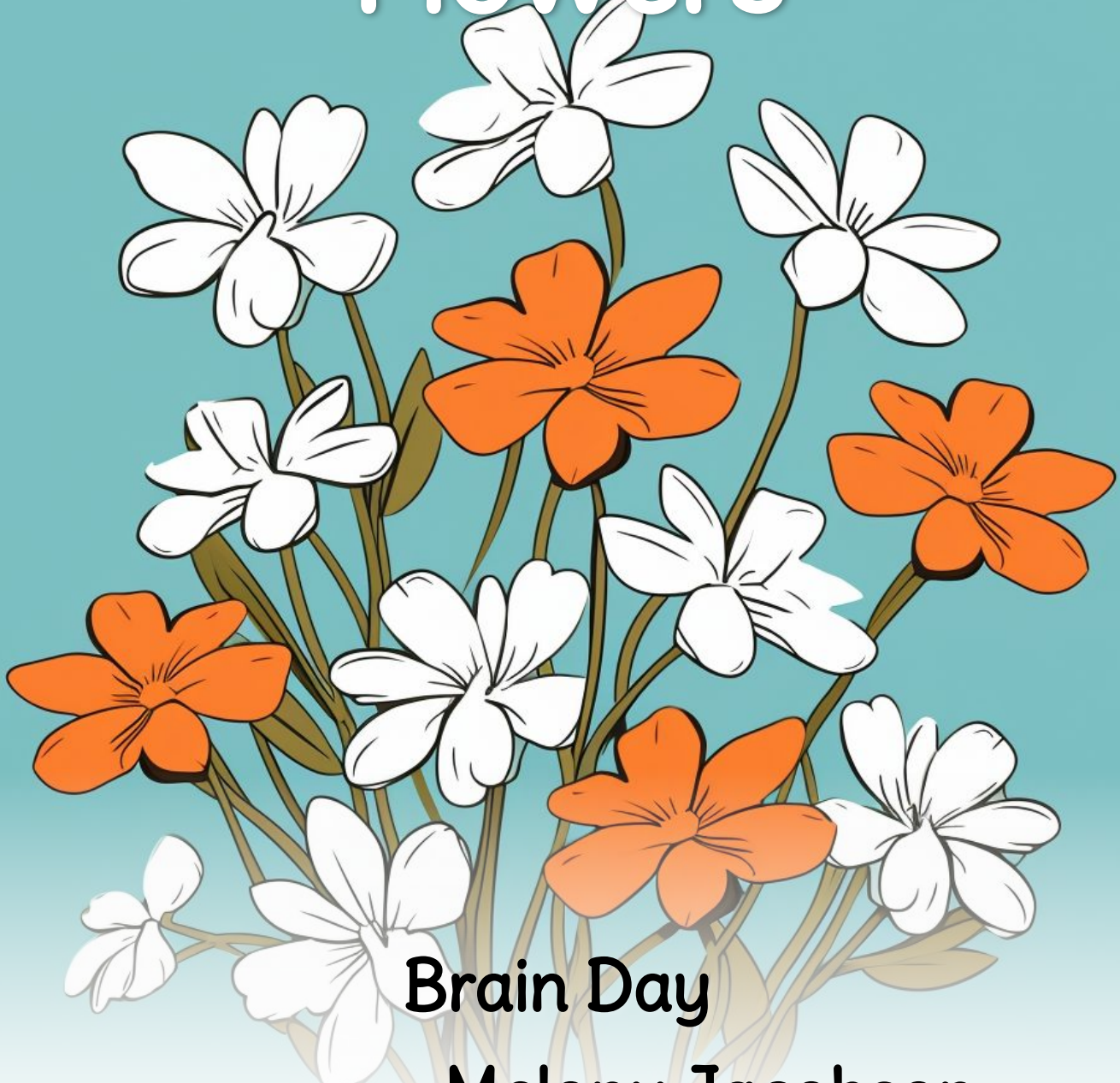

with a sunny yellow center.

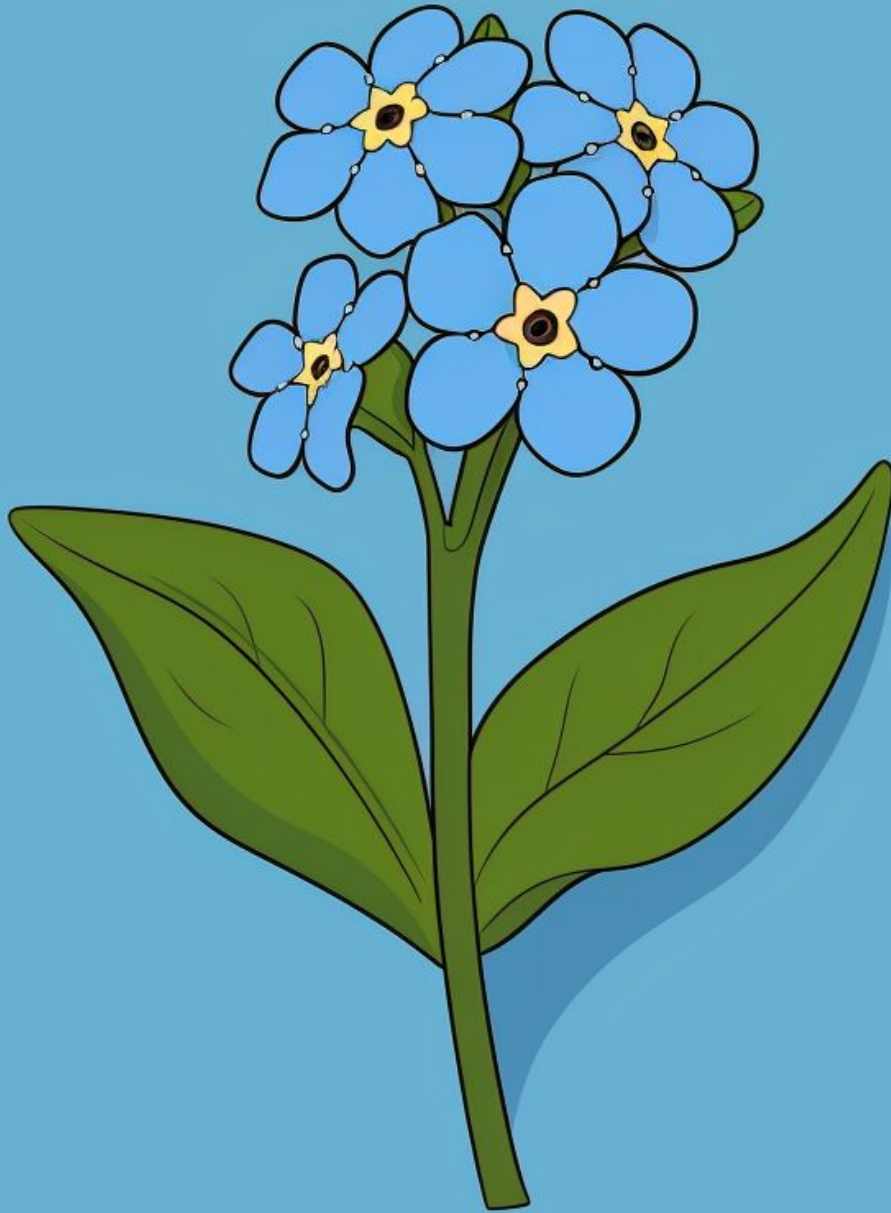


Ee

Xeranthemum

Xeranthemum flowers are small and papery, often used in dried flower arrangements.
