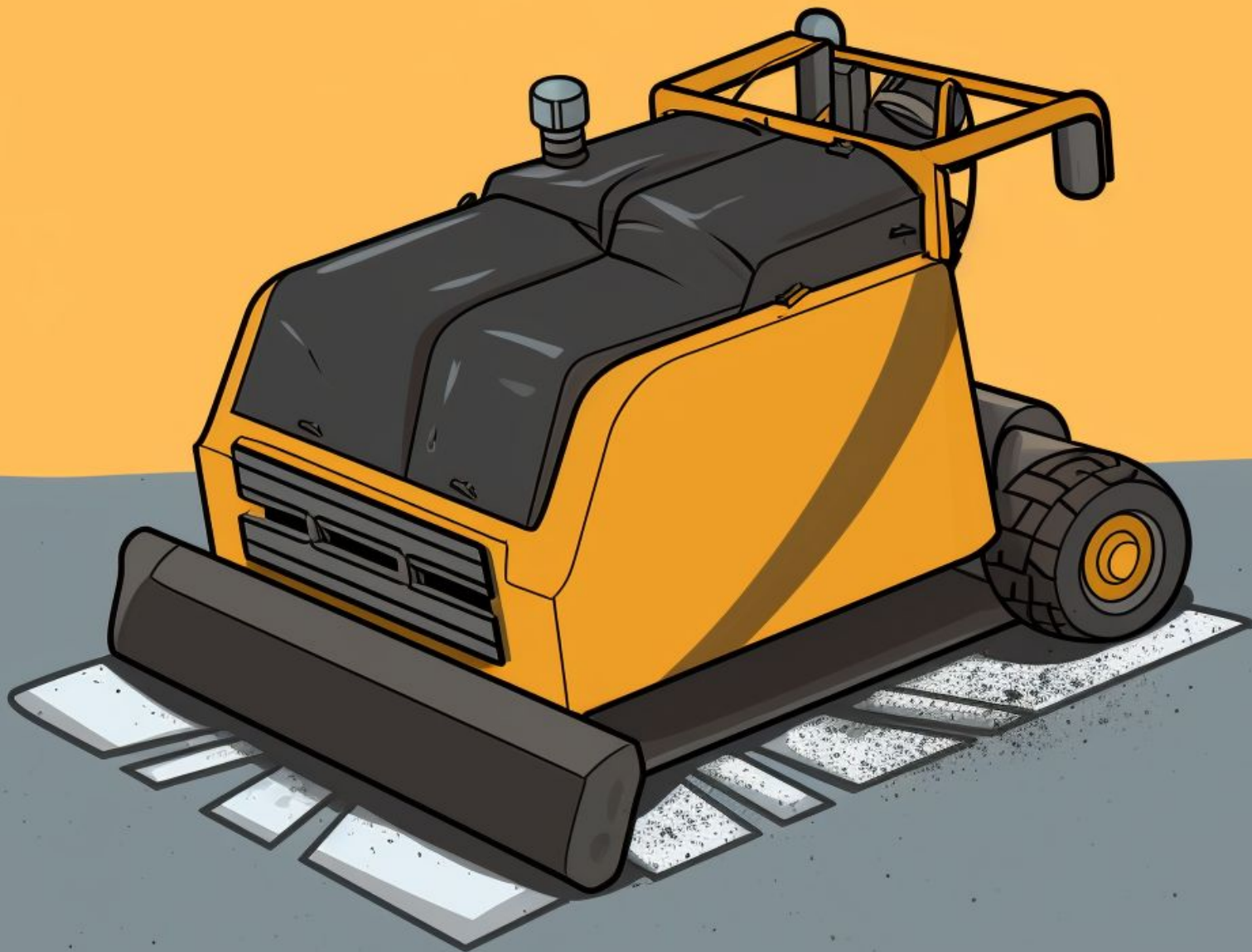

A Dump Truck is a huge truck that can carry lots of dirt, rocks, or sand and then tip it out with a loud "dump" sound.

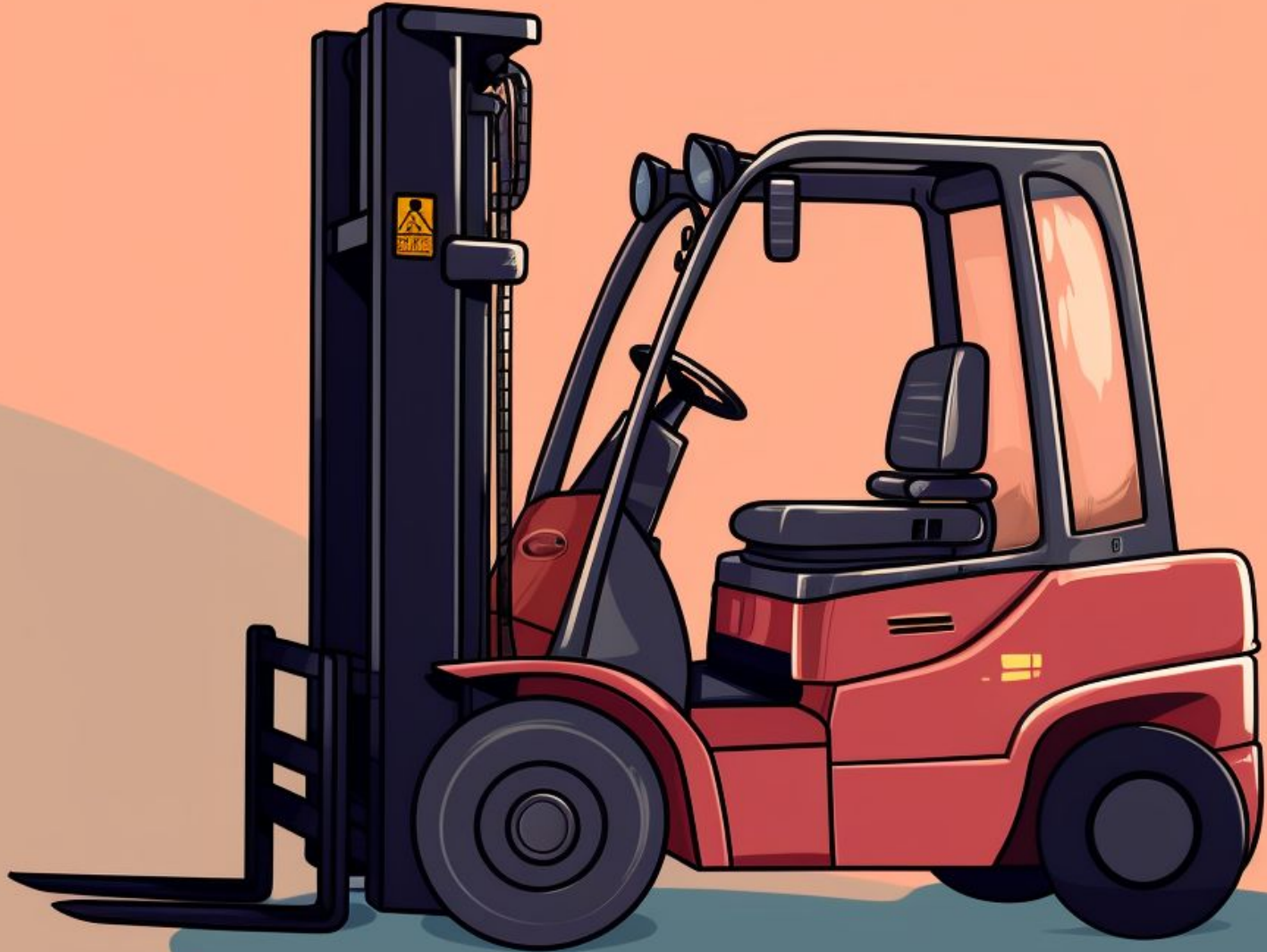


Ee

A Jackhammer is a super loud tool that goes "thump, thump" and helps break up big rocks or concrete.



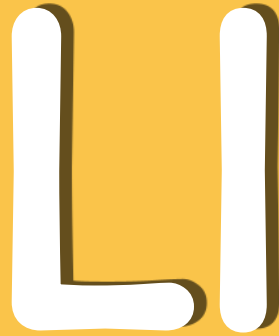
Kk

A Pile Driver is like a big, strong hammer that helps push big poles deep into the ground to make strong foundations.

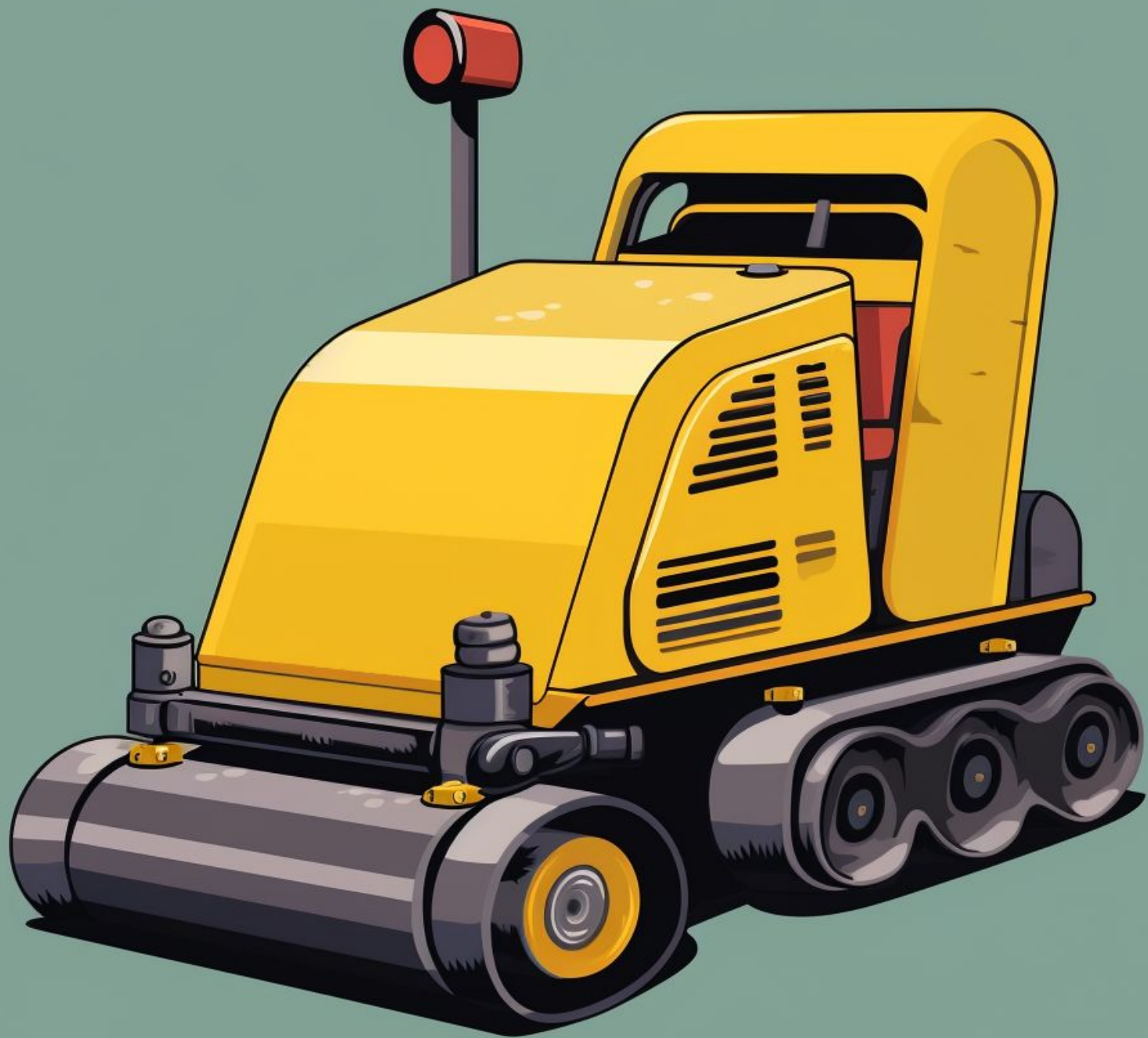


Qq

A Tower Crane is like a tall, giraffe-shaped machine that helps build tall buildings by lifting heavy materials up high.

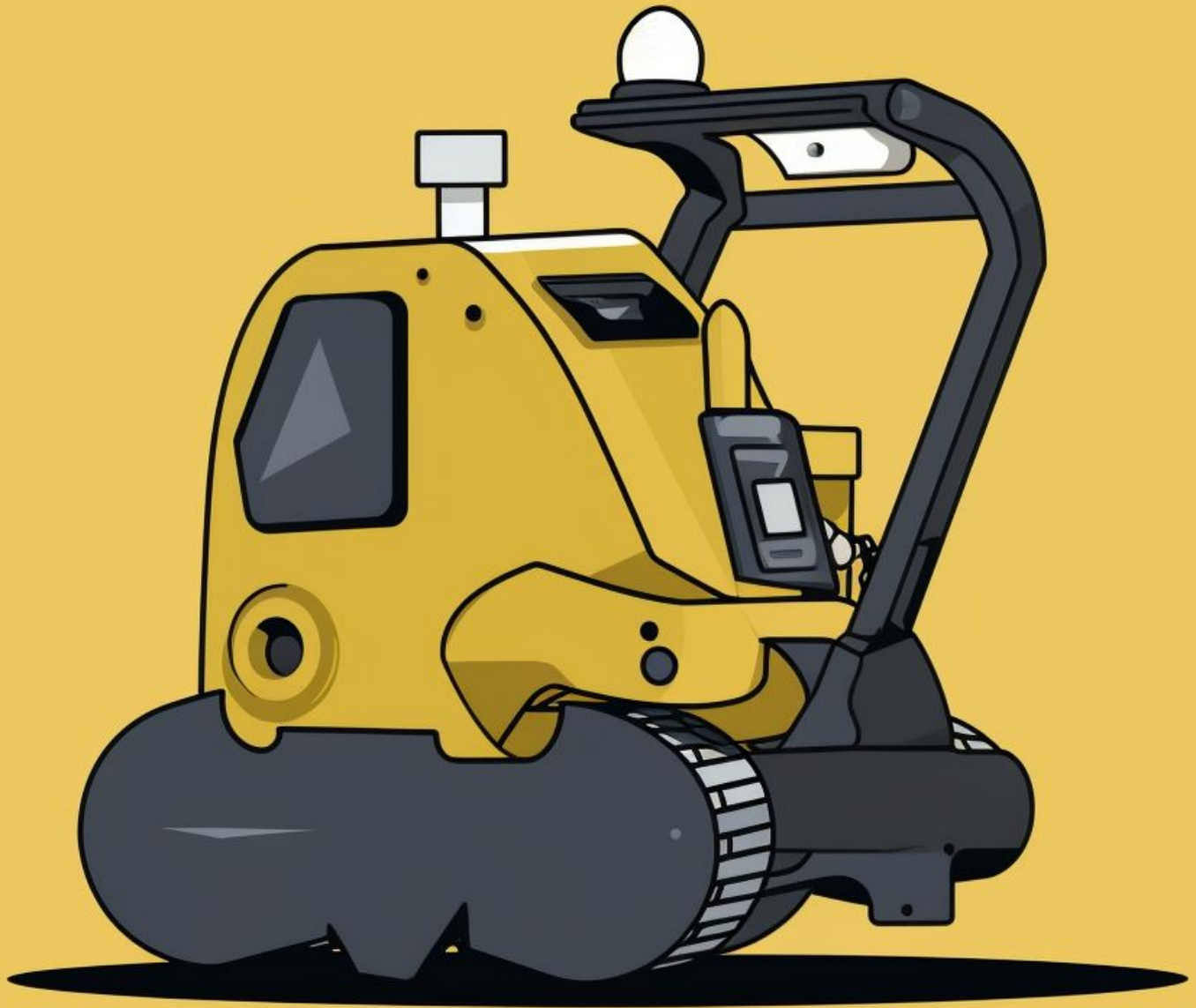


Uu
